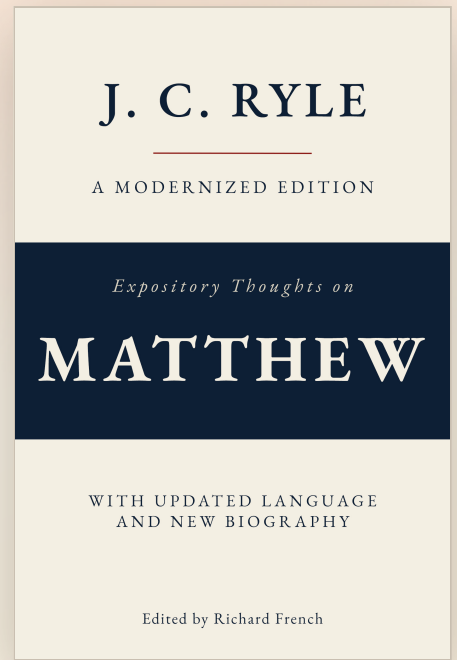

The good news here is genuinely good: a thorough review of all 31 sections found no internal contradictions to flag. Terminology is consistent throughout, every sampled quotation matches its source verbatim, and attributions to the full range of cited voices, Ryle's own prose alongside Chrysostom, Bishop Hall, Brentius, Bucer, Baxter, Augustine, Matthew Henry, Burkitt, Luther, and the various unnamed "old writers", are handled with care and accuracy. Scripture text likewise checks out across the manuscript.

## Character Names and Identities

No discrepancies identified. Named authorities (Chrysostom, Bishop Hall, Brentius, Bucer, Baxter, Augustine, Matthew Henry, Burkitt, Luther) are cited consistently, and unnamed sources remain unnamed throughout, no attributions were introduced or altered.

## Quotations and Source Accuracy

All sampled quotations were located in the manuscript and match verbatim. No section was found to misattribute a quotation or alter wording in a way that conflicts with another section's rendering of the same passage.

# World Concepts and Theological Terminology

No inconsistencies in doctrinal language, key terms, or conceptual framing were identified across the manuscript's 31 sections.
